## Schedule of Brunei Darussalam

Brunei Darussalam may require a natural person of Japan seeking entry and temporary stay under the terms set out in each Section of this Specific Commitments of Brunei Darussalam to obtain an appropriate visa or its equivalent prior to entry.

Section 1
Short-term Business visitors of Japan

Entry and temporary stay of a period not exceeding ninety (90) days, which may be extended, shall be granted to a short-term business visitor of Japan.

# Section 2 Intra-corporate Transferees

Entry and temporary stay for intra-corporate transferees is limited to three (3) year period that may be extended for up to two additional years for a total term not to exceed five (5) years for the following categories:

## Managers:

#### Definition:

Natural persons within the organisation who primarily directs the organisation/department/ subdivision and exercises supervisory and control functions over other supervisory, managerial or professional staff. It does not include first line supervisors unless employees supervised are professionals; and it does not include employees who primarily perform tasks necessary for the provision of the service.

## Executives:

#### Definition:

Natural persons within an organisation who primarily direct the management of the organisation, exercise wide latitude in decision-making and receive only general supervision or direction from higher-level executives, the board of directors, or stockholders of the business. Executives would not directly perform tasks related to the actual provision of the service or services of the organisation.

# Specialists:

Definition:

Natural persons within the organisation who possesses knowledge at an advanced level of expertise essential to the establishment/provision of the service and/or possesses proprietary knowledge of the organisation's service, research equipment, techniques or management; may include, but is not limited to, members of a licensed profession.

Section 3 Investors

Entry and temporary stay shall be granted to an investor of another Party for up to three (3) months which can be extended for up to twelve (12) months.

Investors in Brunei Darussalam is defined as a business person who seeks to make an investment or has made investments in Brunei Darussalam and seeking entry and temporary stay for the purpose of dealing with any matters concerning to that investment.
